### **Camp Information:**

#### **Cancellations & Refunds:**

Chorus Music reserves the right to cancel programs with full refund due to low enrollment. There is no refund for cancellations or missed days without a doctor's note. We will provide full refund if you withdraw from the program 30 days prior to the start date.

#### **What to Bring:**

- Labeled water bottle
- NUT FREE snacks for short morning and afternoon break
- Your instrument (guitar or woodwind instruments, drumsticks, ear plugs.) Campers, if you are planning on renting instruments from us, please do so prior to the first day of camp.

#### **Sign-in and sign-out:**

- Please arrive a few minutes before start time as camp activities start promptly at 9 am.
- For safety reasons, all campers must be signed in and out at reception by a parent/guardian.
- Campers will only be allowed to leave with persons pre-authorized to pick them up.
- We must receive written notice if your camper is to sign themselves out to walk or bus home.
- If your child will be away from camp for the day, please call before 9am and leave us a message.

#### **Camp time and extended care:**

Summer camps run from 9:00am to 4:00pm. Before and after camp care available from 8:00am to 9:00am and from 4:00pm to 5:00 pm each day. Additional cost of \$5.00/day for extended care.

Late pick up will be charged at the rate of \$5:00 for every 15 minute delay.

#### **Lunch and Snacks:**

A pizza lunch is available for an extra fee of \$5.00/day. Lunch includes a choice of either 2 cheese or pepperoni slices and a juice box or water bottle. If you provide a lunch for your child, please ensure it does not require refrigeration or heating. All lunches and snacks must be NUT FREE. Please pack extra snacks for morning and afternoon snack breaks.

#### **Final Performances:**

On the last day of camp, campers present a final performance, showcasing what they have learned through camp. These performances are in the afternoon between 3-5 pm and each camper is welcome to



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invite up to 3 family members or friends to watch. After your child's performance, you can sign him/her out or let the camper watch other performances until the pickup time (4:00 or 5:00 pm).

### **Valuables:**

Chorus Music is not be responsible for any lost or stolen articles. We advise students to leave all valuables at home, or label personal items. Chorus will donate unclaimed items to charity at the end of summer.

### **Accidents & Emergencies:**

If your child is injured, you will be notified immediately. Staff will complete an incident report and our CPR trained staff will assist your child. Camp staff will make any decisions concerning further medical care. During registration, you must sign a waiver form allowing the Camp Supervisors or designated appointee to authorize all procedures, including admission to the hospital and necessary treatment, in the event of an emergency.

### **Illness:**

If your child becomes ill while at camp, you will be notified immediately. Our CPR trained staff will help your child in any way they can. You may need to pick up your child from camp, however. Missed camp days will be refunded with a doctor's note.

### **Medication:**

Please fill out the medical information section during registration if your child requires any prescription medications, they must be provided to reception at morning sign in. Asthma Inhalers and Epi-Pens must be carried by your child at all times. Prescription medications must be in the original pharmacy bottle, labeled with the patient's name and the physician's name who ordered dose on the bottle. Nonprescription and over-the-counter medication will not be permitted. Please contact the camp coordinator if you wish to discuss your child's medications or medical conditions in advance.

### **Camp Rules:**

At Chorus, our goal is to provide a fun, safe, secure, and respectful environment for all campers and staff. We expect all campers to abide by to the following rules:

- Stay with their designated group at all times, participate safely, and follow instructions
- Be respectful of Chorus Music property and property of other campers, staff and guests.
- Follow appropriate dress code. Pants or shorts and t-shirts for all campers and staff.
- Smoking is not permitted during camp hours
- Campers are required to turn off cell phones and electronic devices during camp hours.

**Chorus Music Academy has a zero tolerance policy and campers will get a warning with a call to their parents or could be suspended with no refund in case of:**

1. Bullying, abusive behavior, use of obscene or profane language, use of alcohol or drugs.
2. Stealing/damaging property of the school or others
3. Chorus Music reserves the right to excuse students from the camp for inappropriate conduct.

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
